HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Please see the calendars below for observed holidays that may affect your regular trash and/or recycling collection schedule.

Service days that fall on or after a recognized holiday will be delayed one day that week. Service days that fall before a recognized holiday are not affected and will remain on schedule.

If a holiday is not mentioned in the above schedule, your collection will not be affected.

SERVICE ESSENTIALS



COLLECTION TIME: Trash and recyclables must be out by 5:00 a.m. on the day of service. You may also choose to set your items out the night before.



PLACEMENT: Trash is collected from the area immediately surrounding your underground container or alley. **Do not place anything you want to keep within 10 feet of your trash can so that it not confused as trash.**



CONTAINMENT: Trash must be contained in bins (up to 35 gallons), bags, or boxes, not to exceed 50 pounds (limit of 10 per collection day). If you use a box or other container to dispose of trash or recyclables, mark "SAVE" clearly on the side.



COATED DRIVEWAYS: If you have a painted, coated, or paver driveway, please place your trash and recycling at the curb to prevent damage and/or accidents. Parks & Sons will not be responsible or liable for damage or injury resulting from providing regular services at your home if workers must utilize treated driveways to service your underground can.

RECYCLING COLLECTION

Place your recyclables in the bin(s) of your choice (e.g. cardboard box, basket, plastic bin). **Recyclables must be placed at the end of your driveway on the side opposite of the underground can.**

SPECIAL WASTE



CITRUS: Place your citrus in a bag or container above-ground to prevent injury to employees. Each bag or container should weigh less than 50 pounds.



CACTUS: All cacti must be placed in throwaway boxes and sealed shut to prevent any debris from flying. These boxes will not be returned.



COOKING OILS: If you use any type of cooking oil to be disposed of, contact Customer Service to arrange for a separate pick up free of charge.



SYRINGES: Dispose of your needles in a sealed container such as a coffee can or milk jug.



TRIMMINGS: Yard debris and trimmings must be contained and/or tied in bundles (cannot be loose). Trimmings must be less than 4 feet in length and weigh less than 50 pounds. Tree trunks and branches must be less than 8 inches in diameter.



LARGE/BULK ITEM DISPOSAL: If you have an excessive amount of trash or large items to be disposed of, contact Customer Service to arrange for a special pickup and pricing.



UNACCEPTABLE WASTE: Remodeling or construction debris, dirt, rocks, cement, or roofing shingles cannot be taken with the regular collection. If you need to dispose of these types of items, contact Customer Service to make special arrangements (additional charges will apply).



HAZARDOUS WASTE: Materials such as motor oils, tires, car batteries, chemicals, and paint cannot be placed in the regular trash. For proper disposal methods, contact Customer Service or visit parksandsons.com/hazardous.
